






Exploded Diagram





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

 Note: The operation takes two adults to complete.




STEP 2



Put foot box into the bottom of table and carefully slide it to both sides respectively until it is completely aligned on both sides.



Use the Allen Key (2) to tighten bolts (1) to approximately 100%.




1. Pull the motor cable out through the holes of top panel (A).


The wires need to be securely fastened with wire clips.





Reset Operation:

1. Press and hold the "Downward" button for 5 seconds until "RST" appears on the display.
2. Press and hold the down "Downward" button until you hear a "di" and the display shows the lowest height. During this process, the desk will rebound by about 10 mm. The controller will only function normally after the reset is complete.


1. Insert the power cable into the adapter and turn on the power supply.
2. Once the power is on, you'll need to restore the settings.






Instructions for using the hand controller

* Up and down key operation

Press the hand controller "▲" key, lift the table up, Release the button to stop;

Press the hand controller "▼" key, The lifting table descends, Release the button to stop.

* Location storage and memory runs

The hand controller can store two memory points, and it is repeatable, and can be saved after power failure. The storage method is provided as follows: When running to the appropriate height, short press "S" key, the digital display screen flashes, press any key in "i"、"ii", then the height position of the lifting table is saved to the corresponding key (if there is no key pressed within 6s, exit the memory mode).

After saving, directly press any of the keys in "i"、"ii" directly, and the lifting table automatically goes to the memory position of the corresponding keys. In the process of operation, press any key to stop the operation.

* Lock and unlock

Lock: hold " " key for 5 seconds, when the display screen shows "LOC", indicating that the system is locked and can not lift the system;

Unlock: hold "🔓" key for 5 seconds, when the display screen shows the normal number from "LOC", indicating that the system has been unlocked.

* Sedentary reminder

Press the "T" key, and the digital display will show "0.5H". Each press of the "▲" and "▼" keys adjusts the time setting 0.5H (0.5H = 30 minutes, up to a maximum of 3 hours). After adjusting to the desired duration, press the "S" key to activate the sedentary reminder. When the digital display turns off, a small dot will light up in the lower right corner of the screen. Upon reaching the set time, the hand controller will emit 5 beeps as a reminder, while also displaying the height data. If set to 0.0H, it will be in the off state.

* reset operation

When the system is changed to a new table leg, or the hand controller is abnormal (display **Err**), long press the "▼" key for 5 seconds without release, the system enters the reset mode, and the display screen displays **rES**;

If the "▼" key is released during reset, the lifting table uses the reset mode. Long and press the "▼" key again to continue to reset;

After the reset operation, the hand controller makes a "beep" sound, and then displays the lowest height of the table.

* parameter setting

In no running state, the hand controller presses the "S" key, display "S--" and blink, and press "S" again to enter the menu page.

Under the menu page, press "▲" and "▼" to switch options; then press "S" to enter the setting page, press "▲" and "▼" to modify the parameters under the corresponding menu, and then press "S" to confirm the setting and save the modified parameters. (Exit the parameter menu in 20 second and set and save the modified parameters)
