

Exploded Diagram






PARTS LIST (Carton B)



Before your installation, please make sure that you have all the parts listed on the manual. If you find something missing, stop installing and contact your supplier immediately.


NOTE: Please do not completely tighten all the hardware until the entire assembly is completed! Be sure to tighten all the hardware once the assembly completed.

NOTE:Should be assembled on soft surface to keep balance.




- 1. Place the foam taken out of the packing box under the table as shown.
- 2. Align the foot box (B) downwards with the hole added to the top panel frame as shown.




Use bolts (1) to attach the foot box (B) to the frame of the top panel (A). Tighten with wrench (2) as shown.




- 1.Connect the power cords (3-2) to the power adapter as shown.2.Use round head screws (5) to fix the power adapter (3-1) on the back of the top panel as shown.




Connect the motor and adapter wires to the control box as shown.






Cover the wires with cable tray and tighten them with round head screws (7) as shown.




1.Flip the table upside down in order as shown in the picture, which requires two adults to complete. 2.Open the small flip board on the desktop, insert the socket into the hole, and tighten it with flat head screws (6).




- 1.As shown in the figure, first connect the adapter to the power supply and turn it on.
- 2. The first operation of the controller requires a reset, which stops when the down button displays "LOW".
- 3. After resetting, press the "Up" button to raise the desktop to its highest position.



Align the motor holes on the foot box with the assembly holes on the desktop frame as shown in the picture, and use screws (1) to fully tighten with a wrench (2).


The sound you hear when activating the lifting function is normal and is caused by the high speed of the motor.

Instructions for 0517 Desk Control Panel

1.Desk Elevation

Press and hold the up or down button to control the desk's rise or fall.

When pressing the up button, the height displayed on the display panel will increase. Similarly, pressing the down button will decrease the height displayed.

2.Memory Height Setting

In the height display mode, press a number key to set the desired height, and the desk will automatically move to the saved position.

To save a height, press the memory button "S" briefly; the height number will start flashing. At this point, press sit or stand image button to save the current height to sit or down button. If no action within 6 seconds, it will exit memory mode.

3. Wake Up from Sleep Mode

After the control panel goes to sleep, press any key to light up the display.

4. Sedentary Reminder

- 1. In the height display mode, press the "T" key, and the screen will flash "0.5h".
- 2.Use the up (\blacktriangle) or down (\blacktriangledown) buttons to adjust the reminder time in increments of 0.5 hours. The range is from 0.0 to 3.0 hours.
- 3. Press the "S"key to confirm and set the reminder for the selected duration.
- 4.If the reminder is set to 0.0 hours, the reminder function is disabled.
- 5. Changing the desk height during the set time will reset the reminder timer.

5. Child Lock

- 1. Press and hold the lock button "[a]" for 3 seconds in the height display mode, and the screen will display "LoC", locking other functions (sedentary reminders will still work). Press and hold again for 3 seconds "[a]" to unlock.
- 2. The screen will lock automatically if there is no operation for a long time.

6.Parameter Settings

1. Press and hold the settings button for 3 seconds to display "S--",

2. And press again to enter the settings mode. Parameters that can be set include:

Height display unit: Metric (SI) or Imperial (In);

Collision protection force: Light, Normal, Heavy, or Off;

Tilt protection level: Light, Normal, Heavy, or Off;

Use the back, toggle, and confirm buttons to navigate and save settings.

7. Charging and Display

- 1. Wireless charging will be disabled when the screen is active.
- 2.After the screen turns off, placing a phone on the charger will show "AC", indicating charging is in progress. All buttons will be disabled during charging.
- 3. The screen will turn off after charging is complete.

8. Protection and Alarms

- 1. **Obstacle Detection:** Displays **"E02"**. If the desk collides with something or tilts, the desk will stop and reverse.
- 2. Overheat Protection: Displays "Hot". Wait at least 18 minutes before resuming operation.
- 3. Motor Malfunction: Displays "E10". Check motor connections.
- 4. Overload Protection: Displays "E20". If triggered during upward movement, reduce the load.
- 5. Undervoltage/Overvoltage Protection: Displays "E31" or "E32". Check power connections.
- 6.Step Loss Protection: Displays "E60". Check motor consistency and connections.

9.Reset

In the case of alarms "E10", "E20", or "E60", or when the desk reaches its lowest height, press and hold the reset button for 3 seconds until "E5" (Reset) is displayed. The desk will lower to the minimum height and rebound slightly, completing the reset process.
